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#### Reporting

Unless designated as a confidential resource (Counseling, Health, Director of Spiritual Life), all faculty & staff are expected to report discrimination & harassment to the Director of Title IX & Civil Rights Compliance.

Discrimination based on:

- Gender
- Race
- Color
- Creed
- Religion or religious affiliation
- National or ethnic origin
- Sexual orientation or preference
- Age
- Marital or family status
- Disability
- Veteran status

Disclosures of:Bias incidents

- Dating violence
- Domestic violence
- Sexual Assault
- Sexual exploitation
- Sexual harassment
- Stalking

# Changes with the 2024 Title IX Regulations

- Report disclosures that you learn about in
  - Class assignments
  - Class discussions
- Pregnancy & Related Conditions
  - Provide contact information for the Director of Title IX & Civil Rights Compliance
- IRB approved research that could involve disclosure of sexual violence
  - Note that the researcher is considered confidential for research purpose only

- Provide contact information of the Director of Title IX & Civil Rights Compliance
- Provide information regarding confidential and support resources

## **If Someone Discloses Information:**

- Let them know that you are required to report.
- Let them know that there are confidential resources available.
- The person that discloses retains autonomy.

# Sample Syllabus Statements

## Title IX

As a faculty member, I am required to disclose to the Director of Title IX & Civil Rights Compliance any information I receive about discrimination, harassment, sexual misconduct, and other forms of interpersonal violence. This includes information shared in class assignments, discussions, emails, and/or shared conversations outside of class. If a disclosure is received, she will reach out to you. You are not required to respond to this outreach.
